

Prior to the Glass Warrant interviews of Mr. Jack and his arrest, the younger sister [Z.T.] of Mr. Jack's accuser [T.T.] made several important observations that directly conflicted with T.T.'s allegations. The following excerpts are taken from the recorded interview of Z.T. on the morning of February 18, 2009.

1. T.T. was not alone in her bed at night when the alleged assaults occurred.

*Interviewer:* When you guys were – **were you guys sleeping in the same bed?** *Z.T:* **Yeah.** I have this room, but Angela's cat always went in there and always took (indiscernible) and stuff, **so I always slept in T.T.'s room with her.** (p. 36)

2. Mrs. Jack did not express concerns about Mr. Jack and T.T.

*Interviewer:* Did [Mrs. Jack] ever say anything about Thomas and T.T.? *Z.T:* Um – *Interviewer:* Like their relationship, anything like that? Did you hear anything that she said? *Z.T:* (Shakes head.) Huh-uh.

*Interviewer:* No? Okay. (p.40)

3. Mr. Jack and T.T. were not alone together.

*Interviewer:* So would he go – Thomas go into her room? *Z.T:* Uh-huh. *Interviewer:* And them two in their room by themselves? *Z.T:* (Nods head). *Interviewer:* Or in – *Z.T:* **No, not them two by themselves. T.T. would always stay with me.** *Interviewer:* Uh-huh. T.T. would stay with you? *Z.T:* Wherever I go. *Interviewer:* Or – *Z.T:* So she didn't have to stay by Thomas. *Interviewer:* Okay. **But did it happen sometimes where T.T. and Thomas would be in her room?** *Z.T:* **Huh-uh.** *Interviewer:* **Not that you saw?** *Z.T:* **Huh-uh.** *Interviewer:* She always tried to stay in your room? *Z.T:* She always tried to stay by me, like she was my shadow. *Interviewer:* Uh-huh. *Z.T:* Like every time I'd go outside to play, she was always just playing with me. *Interviewer:* Uh-huh. Okay. **So are there any other times that – any times that you saw Thomas and T.T. go someplace –** *Z.T:* (Shakes head.) *Interviewer:* -- **outside together, or –** *Z.T:* (Shakes head.) *Interviewer:* – **to another place, or if there is an area, like outside of the house?** *Z.T:* (Shakes head.) *Interviewer:* – **Like any other little buildings or anything like that?** *Z.T:* **Huh-uh.** (pp. 41-42)

[Note: this repeated sequence of questions/answers is important because it specifically contradicts the recorded allegations of T.T. that during the day when Angela sent her outside to find something Mr. Jack would accompany her out to a shed where he would kiss her and put his hands on her butt.]

4. Z.T. didn't think her sister had sex with Mr. Jack.

*Z.T:* But they really didn't do it, because if they did, then T.T. would have told me, and I would have told someone. *Interviewer:* Okay. Did – so T.T. didn't tell you that they were doing it. *Z.T:* They didn't do it. (pp. 56-57)

*Interviewer:* Do you think that they ever did it? *Z.T:* No. If T.T. knows – T.T. knows better, and I would have called someone. I would have called our pastor. I would have called like – I don't know who I'd call, but I would have called for some help. Because if – (p. 57)
