February 23, 2009, I had just finished up with my 5th-6th grade READ RIGHT group which consisted of 2-3 students. [REDACTED] was absent so I had [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] waited until [REDACTED] put away his folder and then she asked me if I had heard anything about her? I told her I did not and she said that there were some bad rumors going around about her and [REDACTED] and Tom-Tom. I asked where Tom-Tom was and she said that he was in jail. She told me that the rumors were not true. She said that she wanted me to know that. I told her that I thought Angela and Tom cared very much for her and her sister. I also said that I believed her, and gave her a hug. I went to see Nerci Channel the elementary counselor and told her what [REDACTED] had told me.
